- Good neighbour credentials (i.e. noise, light pollution, transport policies etc).
- Use of recycled materials.
- Offer supporting documentation.
- Show evidence of a deliberate policy of Environmental improvement.
- If you have reduced energy consumption please detail how you have achieved this through developing new work practices.

If you are entering as a school, you should be able to demonstrate:

- Evidence that the environment is a core value that all staff and pupils embrace.
- Evidence that environmental issues are part of the school time and extra time curriculum.
- Evidence of communication and engagement.
- Evidence of benefit to the school.
- Evidence of benefit to the community at large.

Extra points will be awarded in all categories to entrants who include testimonials from those who have benefited from their project. The closing date for entries is Monday 30 January 2012. Submission presentations will take place week starting Monday 6 February 2012 and Final judging, week starting Monday 13 February 2012.
